PCT has been actively collaborating with schools, governments, and organizations for several years to address the issue of Child Sexual Abuse (CSA) and break the silence surrounding it. Initially focused on adolescents aged 13 to 18, the awareness campaign has expanded to include younger children to protect them from potential perpetrators. Swechha For Little Birds is one such initiative aimed at imparting knowledge about safe touch versus unsafe touch, exploitation, and the POCSO act to children at an early age. By conducting classroom awareness sessions through a unique pedagogical approach, in government primary and upper primary schools, we target students between 8 to 12 years old (Grade 3 to Grade 7). A total of 12 young female trainers work on this.

In short, SOE is a year long complementing project that does not disturb existing curriculum. SOE seeks to create a truly excellent educational experience encompasses all aspects of a student's well-being. This quarter we visited the above 7 schools multiple times and conducted workshops.



As a part of a long term collaboration with SVCT, a grassroot level NGO from the northern Andhra Pradesh, we conducted Menstrual Hygiene Education & Adolescent Health Education classes to the girl students of 14 residential schools. In another collaborative event with our long-term associate, Reliance Foundation, we conducted a mega Swechha event for 200+ girl students from the 4 schools of the Gadimoga region.


